After 25 years of service as Albertina Kerr's CEO, I will be retiring in June 2016. COMMUNITY PROMISE

OREGON'S CHILDREN CAN FULFILL THEIR PROMISES WHEN WE KEEP OUR PROMISE TO THEM

Our promise to Oregon's children is a matter of life and death. By investing in proactive services for children and families struggling with acute mental health challenges, we will save lives and replace despair with hope.

Our most ambitious capital campaign in 100 years, the Community Promise campaign is delivering on this promise by creating a 10-acre Children's Mental Health Campus in Gresham. The campus will bring together leading practitioners, critical program services and facilities designed to provide the best possible care for children with acute, high-risk mental health challenges.

With \$5.7 million raised to date, we have completed the expansion of the Crisis Psychiatric Care facility and built a new Intensive Treatment Group Home on campus and a nearby neighborhood-based group home. We are aiming to reach the \$6.5 million construction goal by May 2016 and complete the campus with the renovation of the historic Louise Home to coordinate and deliver community-based mental health services. Once complete, the campus will provide critical mental health services for nearly 1,000 children and their families each year.

The final phase of the Campaign will establish the Community Promise Fund, with \$4.5 million in dedicated planned gifts to create long-term assurance that Albertina Kerr will be able to invest in future improvements and deliver on our promise to be there for vulnerable children well into the future.

HIGHLIGHTS

In addition to the Community Promise capital campaign to build the Campus for Children's Mental Health, we have expanded our promise to Oregon's children and families in a variety of ways over the past year.

PROJECT SEARCH

In collaboration with Kaiser Permanente, the State Office of Developmental Disabilities and the State Department of Vocational Rehabilitation, we implemented Project SEARCH, a national job training program for young adults with developmental disabilities.

CRISIS STABILIZATION GROUP HOMES

We were selected to start a new crisis stabilization group home for youth with developmental disabilities. We also started two new group homes for transition-age (18-24) young adults with developmental disabilities.

EQUITY, DIVERSITY & INCLUSION

Our ongoing commitment to strengthening our equity, diversity and inclusion focus continued to ensure we are implementing best practices to foster a culturally responsive and diverse community, inspiring all members and enriching our capacity to achieve Kerr's mission.

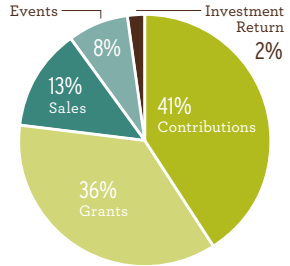
