Your job will be to check dry clothing from racers prior to the start of the race using a number check-in system and retrieve it for them after they have completed the race. This is a fast-paced and busy volunteer opportunity that will work well for the highly organized and positive individual.

RACE COURSE CHEERLEADERS:

Your job will be to set up your aid station prior to race start, fill water cups, set out electrolyte and energy bars for the participants to hydrate as the run or walk past your station. Keep your station stocked for racers and keep the area clean and easy to access. This is a wonderful team-building opportunity for volunteer groups. Be in the midst of the action and cheer on the racers! The most festive and outrageous aid station will win an outstanding prize.

COURSE MONITORS:

[200 Volunteers] *100 stations, with 2 volunteers/ location*

You will be located throughout the race course. There will be police and other volunteers on the course. Your position is to directly support the runners by getting their attention to get them to go into the correct lanes.
